The By-Laws of the Constitution of the Mount Pleasant Michigan Kennel Club state the following regarding membership: "Each applicant for membership shall apply on a form as approved by the Board of Directors and which shall provide that the applicant agrees to abide by these constitution and by-laws and the rules of The American Kennel Club. The application shall state the name, address, and the occupation of the applicant, and it shall carry the endorsement of two members in good standing. Accompanying the application shall be dues for the current year. All applications are to be filed with the Secretary, and each application will be read to the membership at the time of application. If there are no objections, you are a member at the next meeting. Applicants for membership who have been rejected by the Club may not re-apply within six months after such rejection."

Membership Rules:

Dues are paid with membership application. Dues are then paid on January 1st every year after. Dues are \$20.00 per year for an individual or \$25.00 for a family. Additional adults living in the same household are \$5.00 each and juniors are \$10.00 per year. If you wish a key to the building for practicing on your own there is a \$25.00 per year charge payable with annual dues.

If you do not buy a key, you must pay "Floor Time" which is \$10.00 per hour to practice in the building. (Even if you come with a member that has a key) This money helps maintain the building & keep it clean.

The fenced yard is available to all members who buy a key, but not the general public. This is in order to control diseases that might be transmitted by unknowledgeable people and their dogs. Also, in order to limit liability, especially when Agility equipment is set up outside.
